Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Seventh Sunday of Easter! In the Gospel today, we hear an editorial comment inserted into the words of Jesus. “Now this is eternal life, that they should know you, the only true God, and the one whom you sent, Jesus Christ (John 17:3).” The Church is in the midst of the Pentecost Novena, praying intensely for a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon all her members with the celebration of Pentecost next Sunday. It is one thing to pray for the increased manifestation and presence of the Holy Spirit in our time and in our lives. It is all together another thing to pray with the help of the Holy Spirit to know the Lord. I suggest that this comment by the evangelist in today’s Gospel is something we all need to ask of God, the Holy Spirit. —to know truly Jesus Christ. As we pray for the renewed coming of the Holy Spirit, let us also pray this same Spirit will aid all of us in growing in our knowledge and love of God—a personal and intimate knowledge and love. This will lead to a greater commitment to the Christian life and the service of others. *Come, Holy Spirit, Come!*

This is an opportunity to pray in an intense way for the coming of the Holy Spirit to the Church in our time. Also, Archbishop Nelson Pérez will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for Catholic Adults from all over the Archdiocese at the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass on Pentecost.

¡Hoy es el séptimo domingo de Pascua! En el evangelio de hoy, escuchamos un comentario editorial insertado en las palabras de Jesús: “La vida eterna consiste en que te conozcan a ti, único Dios verdadero, y a Jesucristo, a quien tú has enviado” (Juan 17:3). La Iglesia se encuentra en medio de la Novena de Pentecostés, orando intensamente por una nueva efusión del Espíritu Santo sobre todos sus miembros, con miras a la celebración de Pentecostés el próximo domingo. Una cosa es orar por una mayor manifestación y presencia del Espíritu Santo en nuestro tiempo y en nuestras vidas; otra muy distinta es orar, con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo, para conocer al Señor. 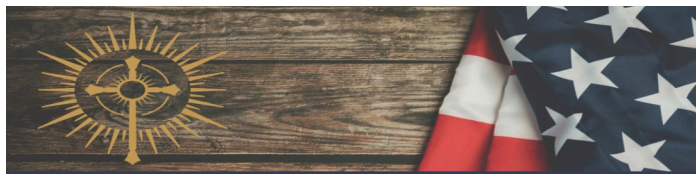

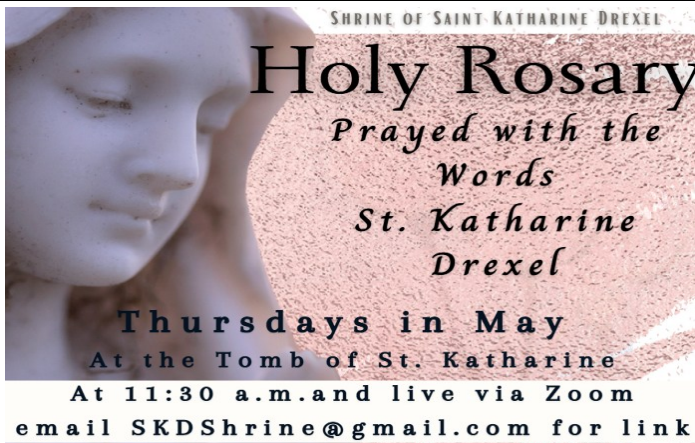
**LUMINESCENCE AT THE

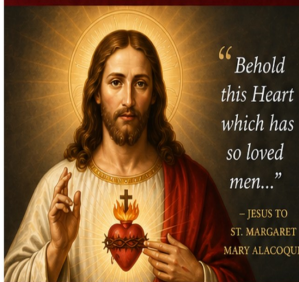

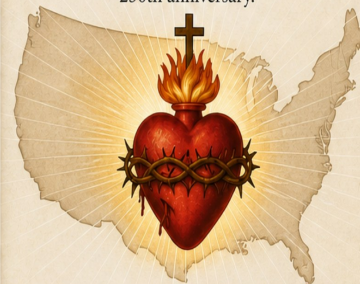
