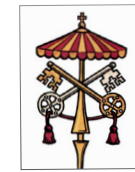

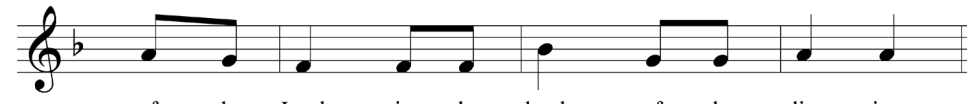

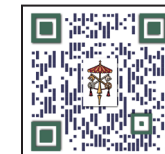

More to enravish, as they this tune sing.



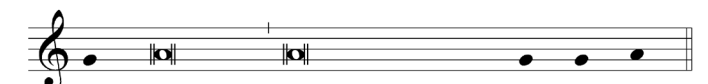
