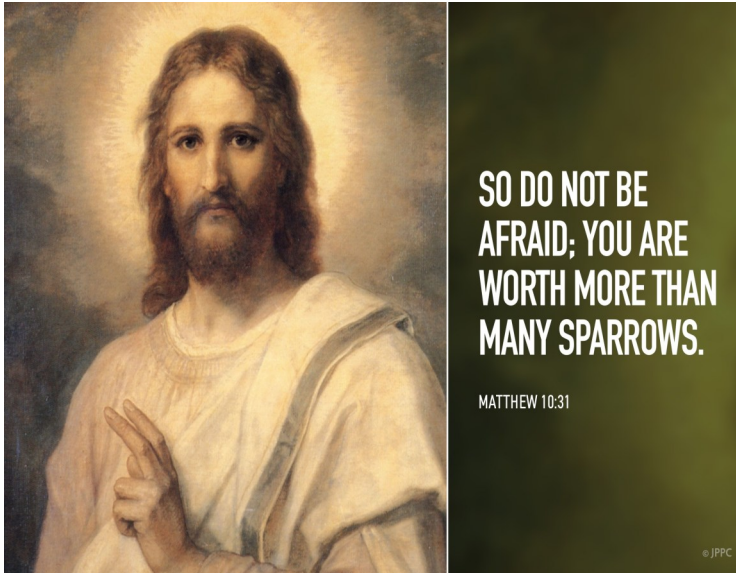

Dear Parishioners,

*This is the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time.* The Holy Gospel for this Sunday (see Matthew 10: 26-33) exhorts us to fear no one. Rather, with every confidence in the providence of God for us, we are called to be faithful. God gives us the grace necessary to commit to the Gospel of his Son with a remarkable fidelity. Let us heed the word of God in every part of our lives for his glory, for our own sanctity and for the benefit of others.

*Today, we observe Father's Day.* This is an occasion to pray especially for our fathers, living or dead. The vocation of fatherhood deserves renewed attention and respect. More and more studies indicate the powerful influence a father has on his children, especially when it comes to living the Faith. For a variety of reasons, fatherhood in more recent times has been diminished and needs to be reclaimed with regard for its dignity and purpose in the family and in society. So, we pray earnestly for our fathers. Let us also encourage fathers in their role and support them in their vocation to lead their children to Christ. *Happy Father's Day to all fathers!*

*Religious Freedom Week 2026 begins tomorrow with the Memorial of Saints John Fisher and Thomas More, June 22, and will conclude on the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, June 29, 2026.* This week is an invitation for all Catholics to reflect on the value of our freedom to express our faith in society and to do whatever is possible to protect this freedom. *Next Monday, June 29, 2026, is the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles, the patrons of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia and of our Cathedral Basilica.* We will celebrate our feast day twice. On the actual day, we will commemorate these Holy Apostles at the 7:15 AM Mass in the Chapel and at the 12:05 PM Mass in the Cathedral Basilica. Next Sunday, we will observe the Solemnity at all the Sunday Masses, including the Anticipated Mass. We turn to our heavenly patrons to pray for us, especially in these days, that we may be faithful to Jesus in every way.

*The celebration of the anniversary of the Dedication of the Cathedral Basilica is on Tuesday, June 30, 2026, and will be observed at the 7:15 AM Mass in the Chapel and at the 12:05 PM Mass in the Cathedral Basilica.*
